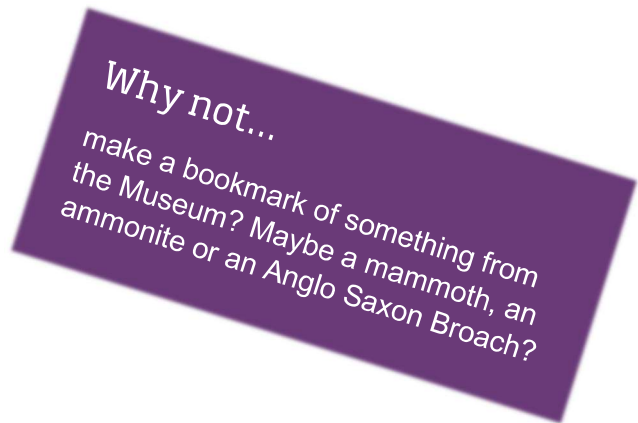







Make Your Own Bookmark

What will I need?

- A sheet of paper or card
- A ruler or something with a straight edge
- Colouring pens, pencils or paints
- Scissors



What do I do?

1. Use your ruler to draw a straight line on a piece of paper or card. We suggest making it 5 - 10cm from the edge. Cut along the line so you have a strip.
2. Fold over one end. If your strip is 10cm wide, you would want to make the fold about 10cm from the end, in order to create a square.
3. Draw a picture on your square, making sure that it comes into contact with the folded edge at the top.
4. Colour in your design with whatever you have to hand. You could use pencils, pens or paints.
5. Cut around the left and right sides of your design and along the bottom. Along the folded edge at the top, only cut away the spare bits on either side (with our cat, we only cut away the white areas, not the bit between its ears.)
6. Your bookmark is finished! Simply place it in your book with the picture over the page you are on.
