Aerial Survey - a way of collecting images or data of the ground from the air.

Archaeology - the study of the buildings, graves, tools, and other objects that belonged to people who lived in the past.*

Cropmark - a feature in fields that might indicate the presence of archaeology under the ground.

Dendrochronology - a way of calculating dates and the age of objects by counting the rings that appear inside tree trunks.*

Excavation - removing earth that is covering very old objects buried in the ground, in order to discover things about the past.*

Fieldwalking - systematically walking across a field and recording artefacts found on the surface.

Geoarchaeology - applying a combination of Earth sciences, such as geography, geology, geophysics, to better understand archaeological information.

Geophysics - A method of identifying archaeological features under the Earth's surface by monitoring the magnetic field in the earth.

Harris Matrix - a method used to illustrate layers in the earth from different time periods.

Investigation - the act or process of examining something carefully, especially to discover the truth.*

Isotopic Analysis - the identification of chemical elements within organic and inorganic materials.

Osteoarchaeology - the study of excavated human skeletons.

Palaeopathology - the study of past diseases by looking at human remains.

Radiocarbon Dating - a method used to estimate the age of carbon-based materials that originated from living things.

Science - (knowledge from) the careful study of the structure and behaviour of the physical world.*

Stratigraphy - the study of the different layers (or strata) in the earth, which can reveal how old archaeological finds are.
